Exotic hardwood flooring from East Teak can take any project far beyond standard wood floors. Choose from any of the following high-density woods that wear well and readily accept finishes including:



**SAPELE**, a durable wood with medium to fairly dark reddish-brown or purplish-brown tones, with “ribbon striped” figures



**KEMPAS**, an Asian hardwood with colors from light pinkish brown freshly milled to reddish brown and yellowish red upon exposure to light



**IPÉ**, one of the hardest and most durable timber species in the world, with colors ranging from dark brown to olive brown to almost blackish tones, with wide variation in grains

East Teak offers strip flooring, which is denoted by the width of the wood, in a variety of species. This particular flooring has a set width, however custom sizes are available. East Teak also offers plank flooring that comes in standard or custom sizes.

In addition, we can use several customized flooring techniques that bring out various appearances and characteristics to the woods. When applied, each board gives off a unique and distinctive characteristic, resulting in a personally crafted project that shows age and character.

## ONE-OF-A-KIND APPLICATIONS

**Hand-hewn flooring** offers an Old World, lived-in appearance, which is created by a simple draw-knife craftsman hand hewing technique. As a result, the solid teak gives a unique impression of age and character, right down to the eased plank edges and ends.

**Rustic flooring** brings out the natural characteristics of teak. Sometimes referred to as tavern-grade or character-grade, rustic teak highlights multiple grain patterns and tight knots to achieve a rustic, country-style look.

**Distressed flooring** is new wood made to look like it is old. New planks are hand-

## ADDITIONAL EXOTIC WOODS INCLUDE:

**JATOBA**, referred to as Brazilian cherry, is a dense and durable wood and is extremely popular for flooring

**AFRORMOSIA**, a dense hardwood which offers “ribbon striped” figures and is uniform in color

**TIGERWOOD**, a dense and durable wood, with colors that range from a light golden brown to red, and with brownish-black streaks which darken gradually over time, accentuating its distinctive grain

**MERBAU**, an Asian hardwood with colors from yellow to orange brown freshly milled, and bronze to dark red upon exposure to light
