



Exotic Decking

Exotic South American hardwoods can enhance any residential or commercial deck, and East Teak Fine Hardwoods, Inc. features a wide range of exotic decking, including:

IPÉ, sometimes called Brazilian Walnut, is recognized as one of the hardest and most durable timber species in the world, with colors ranging from dark brown to olive brown and sometimes almost blackish tones. Ipé is also one of the most dense woods in the world, which results in a high fire-resistance rating and natural resistance to rot and decay.

Ipé is available air-dried (AD) or kiln-dried (KD) in these standard sizes:
